

“-ing” Spelling rules:

1. **General rule:** base form (1st column of verbs) + -ing
2. In **1 syllable words ending in CVC** (consonant-vowel-consonant), **we double the consonant:**
Run (1 syllable + CVC) **running**
Get: **getting**
Write (**NO CVC ending**) ~~writting~~ but writing
3. **The final Silent “-e”**, we drop the “-e” before adding “-ing”
Make – mak(~~e~~)ing -making
Dance: - danc(~~e~~)ing- dancing
4. When the base form ends in **“-Y”** the “-y” remains the same
