

Plural of nouns

I Choose the plural forms of the following words:

tomato *tomatos / tomatoes*

box *boxs / boxes*

kilo *kilos/ kiloos*

photo *photos / photoes*

Explanation: the last two words are of foreign origin and add -S only! Other nouns ending in -o normally add -es.

II Choose the plural forms of these words:

Knife *knifes / knives*

Leaf *leaf / leaves*

Loaf *loafs / loaves*

Explanation: Some nouns ending in -f change -f into -v and then add -es. (*calf, half, knife, leaf, loaf, self, shelf, thief, wife, wolf, elf, hoof, scarf, wharf*)

Other nouns ending in -f only add -s.

Explanation: These words have irregular plural forms!
