James Cook (be) born on 27 October 1728 near Middlesborough in Yorkshire,
England.
Who was James Cook?
James Cook (be) a British explorer, navigator and cartographer ((draw) maps).
What is James Cook famous for?
James Cook (discover) the Hawaiian Islands and (bring)Australia and New Zealand into the British Empire. He (be) the first British ship commander to circumnavigate the globe in a lone ship. He was also the first British commander to prevent the outbreak of scurvy by regulating his crew's diet, serving them citrus fruit and sauerkraut to prevent the disease. In October 1769, he (become) the first European to land on New Zealand.
James Cook charted many areas and (record) several islands and coastlines on European maps for the first time. He explorations and maps (provide) much information about the Pacific Ocean, and about those who (live) on its islands and shores.
Cooke was killed on 14 February 1779 at Hawaii.
Legacy
James Cook (explore) and mapped more territory than any navigator of his time and (provide) the first accurate map of the Pacific. In addition, his expedition (discover) thousands of new plant species and many new animals. Artists on his expeditions rendered valuable paintings and drawings of the Pacific
