The name "Prometheus" means "the fore thinker". One Greek philosopher wrote that all arts, all skills, men owe to the forethinker. By this he meant that civilization is founded on fire and using fire. When man eventually learned how to use fire, he guarded it carefully. Some ancient peoples **worshipped** fire as a goddess. Even when man learned to make fire whenever he liked, often kept sacred fires burning.
