PAST CONTINUOUS

- + The penguin **was looking** for food.
- We **were talking** about the journey.
- ? Were you **wearing** a swimsuit?
- Yes, I **was**. / No, I **wasn't**.

While I **was walking** on the beach, I **found** an old box.

We **were swimming** when it **started** to rain.

We **were taking** photos while the ship **was setting off**.
