

# Advent

We hang up *mistletoe* as a decoration. If someone is standing under the mistletoe, you have to kiss them! Each time you *kiss* someone you have to remove a berry, when they're all gone, no more kissing!



A carol is a traditional Christmas song about Jesus and the time that he was born. *Carol singers* sing these carols in the public places. Often they will knock on peoples' doors and sing in order to collect money for charity.

In December we send out *Christmas cards* to friends and family to wish them a 'Merry Christmas'!



On Christmas Eve we leave out a *mince pie* and some *sherry* for Father Christmas, and some *carrots* for his reindeer.



On Christmas Eve we hang up a *stocking*. Santa leaves small presents in the stocking. These presents are opened first.

The *Advent Calendar* counts down to Christmas. Every day a new window is opened to reveal a picture, chocolate or small gift.
