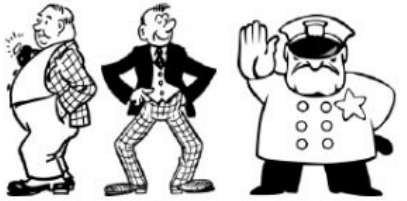


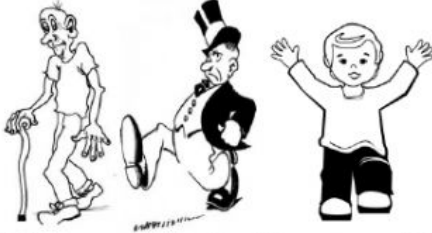
# Comparatives and Superlatives

James      Tom      Robert

- 1) James is .....than Tom. (fat)
- 2) Tom is ..... than Robert. (slim)
- 3) Robert is the ..... (fat)



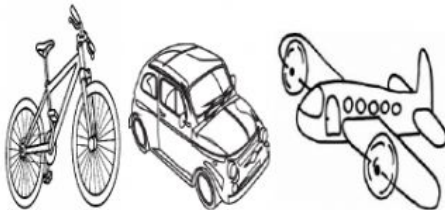
Oliver      David      John

- 1) John is .....than David. (young)

Leopard      Turtle      Rabbit

Bicycle      Car      Plane

Football      Tennis      Basketball

David's family Ann's family George's family



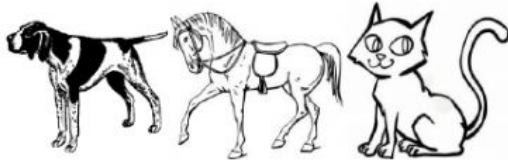
Tree 1 Tree 2 Tree 3
