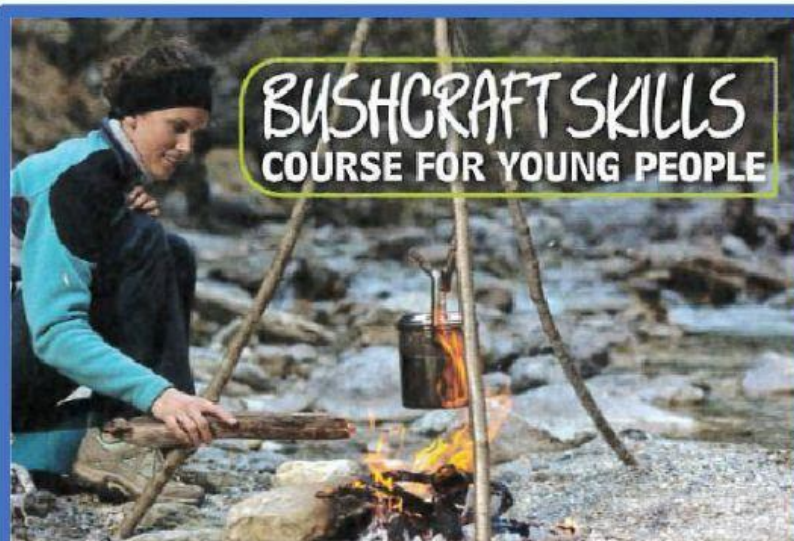
Bushcraft describes the skills we need to stay alive in the wild, for example how to look for drinking water or build a fire.
