

PHRASAL VERBS: BREAK

DOWN: become very upset or emotional
stop working properly (machines)

OPEN: open something by force

OUT: when something (often dangerous) suddenly begins
escape from a situation or a place

BREAK

IN ON: interrupt a conversation

INTO: enter a place illegally

THROUGH: force yourself through something that is holding you back.

UP : when a business or a personal relationship ends.
divide something into smaller pieces
