WHAT DO I NEED TO KNOW?

1. There are two types of verbs: **Regulars** and **Irregulars**.

2. All the **regular verbs**, follows a word pattern and, always end with the letters **ED** in past and past participle.

3. For example:

accept - accepted- accepted

ask - asked - asked

listen - listened- listened

4. All the **irregular verbs** follows a different pattern.

For example:

eat - ate - eaten

know - knew - known

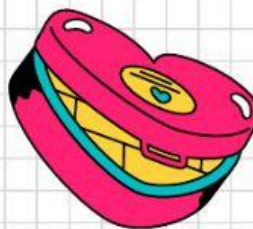
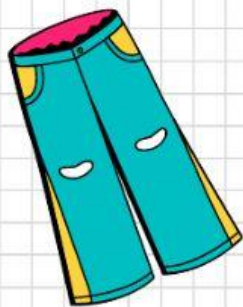

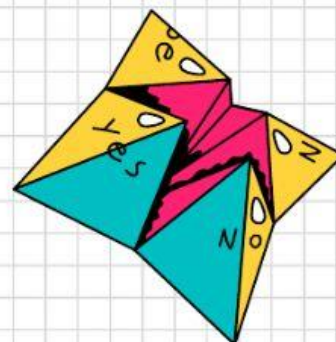
