

## OBJECT PRONOUNS

<i>Subject pronouns</i>	<i>Object pronouns</i>
I	<i>me</i>
you	<i>you</i>
he	<i>him</i>
she	<i>her</i>
it	<i>it</i>
we	<i>us</i>
you	<i>you</i>
they	<i>them</i>

- We use a ***subject personal pronoun*** before a verb instead of the noun or the name of a person.

*He is a vet.*

*She works in a school.*

*We live in London.*

- We use the ***object personal pronouns*** after verbs or prepositions as objects.

*I like Peter. I like him.*

*Look at the girls. Look at them.*
