John: Really? What kind of problems?
Tom: When we (get) home from the cruise, we (find) out that somebody (break) into our house. Yes, someone (find) out about our winning and (try) to rob us.
John: it (take) anything valuable?
Tom: No, while the burglar (try) to enter, he (activate) the alarm and the police (arrive) quickly.
