DOWN: - not accept an invitation or offer

AROUND: change direction

-decrease volume

IN: -give an assignment to a teacher

UP: - appear - increase

- go to bed

- deliver a criminal to the police

INTO: become

TURN

ON: start a machine, light OFF: stop a machine, light

**OUT:** have a particular result, often unexpected
