\*He, she, it → does /doesn't

\*I, you, we, they → do/ don't

Do/ Does we go to school every day? Yes, we do/ does.

Do/ Does they go to bed at night? No, they don't/ doesn't.

Do/ Does you write a letter? No, I don't/ doesn't.

Do/ Does she run in the afternoon? Yes, she do/ does.

Do/ Does he do the homework every day? Yes, he do/ does.

Do/ Does they read a comic in the library? No, they don't/ doesn't.
