

Today we will learn about the COMMA

A <u>comma</u> is used to show a pause.

When making a list, commas are the way to separate one item on the list from the next. The final two items in the list are usually separated by an "and" or an "or".

 There were cups, plates, spoons, forks and knives on the table.

Commas are written at the bottom of a page line.

They hang off the line on the page.
