While + Subject (S) + was/were + Verb(V)+ing , S + S.past form of the verb.

When + S + S.past form of the verb , S + was/were + Verb+ing.

S + S.past form of the verb While + S + was/were + Verb+ing.

S + was/were + Verb+ing When + S + S.past form of the verb.

Don't use a comma

TO EXPRESS SIMULTANEOUS SHORT ACTIONS.

When + S + S.past form of the verb , S + S.past form of the verb .

S + S.past form of the verb When + S + S.past form of the verb. → (No comma)

TO EXPRESS SIMULTANEOUS LONG ACTIONS.

While + S + was/were + Verb+ing , S + was/were + Verb+ing.

S + was/were + Verb+ing While + S + was/were + Verb+ing . → (No comma)
