

PREPOSITIONS OF PLACE (AT, IN, ON)

AT

- When we talk about a specific point or place



The cat is **at** the window

He is **at** the top of the mountain



- To talk about an exact address (we know the name of the street and the number)

He lives **at** 55 Oxford Street

Be careful! If you don't know the number – He lives on Oxford Street

- Events

She is at a party.

He is at a conference/meeting.

We are at a concert.

- Building where an event or activity takes place:

I'm **at** the cinema.

At the library

At the townhall

At the police station



- Somebody's house

I'm **at** Andrew's house

He lives **at** his grandparents' house

- Other expressions

At school

At home

At work

At university

At reception

At church

ON

- To talk about a position in contact with a surface

The pictures are **on** the wall

On the table

On the page

On the floor



- With 'COAST', 'ROAD TO', 'THE OUTSKIRT OF', 'THE EDGE', 'THE BORDER', 'THE WAY'ETC.

They are **on the** Mexican **coast**.

We are **on the road** to the petrol station

She lives **on the outskirts** of London

The phone is **on the edge** of the table

We are **on our way** home.

- With means of transports (but not cars or taxis, they go with in)

I'm **on** the plane

She is **on** the train

- Technology

She's **on** the phone

I saw your photo **on** Facebook



- Left and right

There's a cat **on the right** and a dog **on the left**



- Floor, farm, island, premises and list

We're **on** the 5th floor

You're not **on** the list

IN

- Enclosed space with boundaries

In the bedroom

In the kitchen

In the bag

In the garden

In the forest

- Towns or cities

In Fraga

In London

In the village

- For taxi and car

I'm **in** the car /taxi
