

## Present Perfect Form

Remember the classification you learned for the past tense: REGULAR AND IRREGULAR VERBS. In this tense, regular verbs are the same, they end in "ed" but the irregular verbs may change so you have to pay attention to the THIRD column.

	Positive	Negative	Question
<b>I / you / we / they</b>	I have spoken.	I have not spoken.	Have I spoken?
<b>he / she / it</b>	He has spoken.	He has not spoken.	Has he spoken?
