

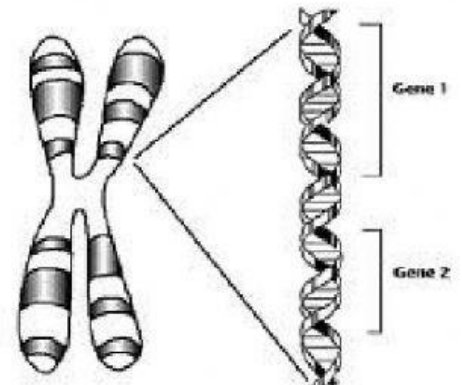
DNA
