- (1) A piece of furniture with shelves to put books on
- (2) A large, soft, flat bag filled with feathers or artificial material used as a covering on a bed
- (3) A piece of kitchen equipment that uses electricity to preserve food at a cold temperature
- (4) A thick, soft material used for covering floors
- (5) A piece of equipment that you hold in your hands and use to control a television, DVD player, etc.
- (6) The covering that forms the top of a building, vehicle, etc.
- (7) A part of a fence or outside wall that is fixed on one side and opens and closes like a door, usually made of metal or wooden strips

- (8) A small dish or container, sometimes decorative, which is used by smokers to put their cigarette ends
- (9) A box-shaped container, without a top, that is part of a piece of furniture. It slides in and out to open and close and is used for keeping things in
- (10) A piece of glass with a shiny, metal-covered back that reflects light, producing an image of whatever is in front of it. It can often be found in the bathroom above the washbasin
- (11) A flat cover made from wool or similar warm material, usually used on a couch
- (12) A machine that washes dirty plates, cups, forks, etc.
- (13) A covered structure in front of the entrance to a building
- (14) A device that controls the flow of water from a pipe, for example in the kitchen or bathroom
- (15) Another word for “row house”
- (16) A structure of wood or wire forming a kind of a wall around a house or a garden, often to keep people or animals from coming in or going out
- (17) The opposite of “huge”
- (18) A bowl that is attached to the wall in a kitchen or bathroom in which you wash dishes or your hands, etc.
