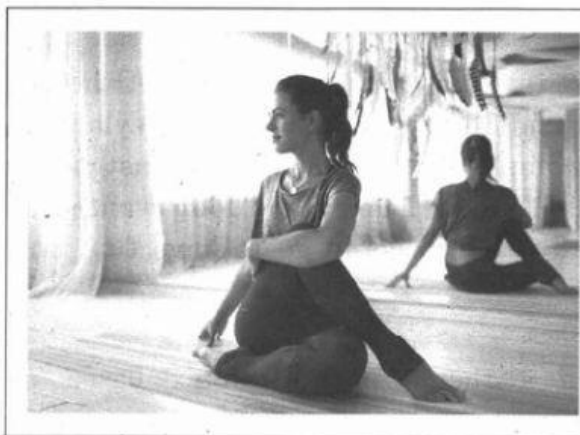

C. Busch Gardens is an animal theme park based in Tampa, Florida. The park is themed around Africa and combines rollercoasters with wildlife. The park features some of the tallest rollercoasters in the U.S., as well as over 12,000 animals. There are also "Bird Gardens" with over 500 tropical birds and the "Edge of Africa" area, with crocodiles, lions, hyenas, hippos and giraffes.

D. Six Flags is an amusement park corporation based in the United States. It has 25 locations throughout North America. The first Six Flags was founded in Texas in 1961 and was called "Six Flags Over Texas". The name originally refers to the six nations that have governed Texas: Spain, France, Mexico, the Republic of Texas, the United States of America and the Confederate States of America.

E. Paultons Park is one of the few famous British amusement parks. Located in Romsey, England, the park is sometimes called the Home of Peppa Pig Cartoon World. Most of the rides in this amusement park are designed for children, so Paultons Park is considered a family theme park.
