Interrogative
Do I/you like fish?
Does he/she/it like fish?
Do we/you/they like fish?

Yes , I/you do ./ No , I/you don't .
Yes , he/she/it does ./ No , he/she/it doesn't .
Yes , we/you/they do ./ No , we/you/they don't .
