Use a/an with singular countable nouns	
- the first time you mention a thing / person.	I saw an old man with a dog.
- when you say what something is.	It's a nice house.
- when you say what somebody does.	She's a lawyer.
- in exclamations with What!	What an awful day!
- in expressions like	three times a week

Use the - when we talk about something we've already mentioned. - when there's only one of something. - when it's clear what you're referring to. - with places in a town, e.g. cinema and theatre. I saw an old man with a dog, and the dog was barking. The moon goes round the Earth. He opened the door. I'm going to the cinema.

Don't use the

- with superlatives.

- when you are speaking in general (with plural and uncountable nouns). Women talk more than men. Love is more important than money.
- with some nouns (e.g. home, work, school, church) after at/ to / from. She's not at home today. I get back from work at 5.30.
- before meals, days, and months. I never have breakfast on Sunday.
- before next / last + days, week, etc. See you next Friday.
