-The Imperative is the Infinitive without to.

**Affirmative:** Sit down!

**Negative:** Don't sit down!

-We use the Imperative in:

- **Instructions:** Open your books.
- **Warnings:** Look out!
- **Offers:** Have some juice.
- **Advices:** Stay at home. Don't go to school if you are ill.
- **Requests:** Pass the sugar, please.
- **Invitations:** Come for dinner.
