

Active or Passive Verbs


Learning the difference between active and passive voice can be tricky. Both types of sentences use action verbs. The difference is how the action relates to the subject.

In **ACTIVE VOICE**, the subject performs the action.




*Oliver grew carrots in his garden.

In **PASSIVE VOICE**, the subject receives the action.



*The carrots in the garden were grown by Oliver.



*The bunny devoured Oliver's carrots.




* Oliver's carrots were devoured by the bunny.

The bat gulped the moth.




4. ☐ Active ☐ Passive
