



PRESENT PERFECT: ALREADY, JUST AND YET.

Rewrite the sentences using the **Present Perfect** and adding **already, just and yet**.

1) My family and I were at a restaurant and the waiter asked me: "Have you ever tried sushi?" so I answered:

For example: I / eat / sushi. (already)

I have already eaten sushi.

2) An exchange student from Germany at school knows that his new friend has not visited Germany but she has plans to go soon.

She / visit / Germany. (yet)

3) They bought tickets to see a movie but they realized that they have seen it before.

They / see / this movie. (already)

4) His parents arrived at home 5 minutes ago after being at his school with his teacher.

We / meet / your teacher. (just)

5) His brother is still on holidays but he will start school in a month.

My brother / start / school. (yet)

6) Daniel didn't fix the pipe but he will do it soon.

Daniel / fix / the broken pipe. (yet)



7) My daughter realize that she left her purse at the bar 7 minutes ago.

My daughter / lose / her purse. (just)



8) I asked him: "Why aren't you working?" so he answered:

I / finish / the assignment. (just)

9) My son had an accident at a birthday party and one of the moms who was there brought him home and told me:

Your son / break / his arm. (just)
