Simple { I **use** my laptop to work.

= The laptop **is used** (by me) to work.

Present { We **practice** English exercises.

= English exercises **are practiced** (by us).

Simple { You **wrote** a text in June.

= A text **was written** (by you) in June.

Past { You **did** different activities.

= Different activities **were done** (by you).

Can you notice the difference?

Active Voice

(Esta es la voz activa, la que conocemos desde que uno comienza a estudiar Inglés)

S + V + O (+ C)
(subject) (verb) (object) (complement)

Passive Voice

(Y aquí, la voz pasiva, otro orden y con un cambio en la forma del verbo)

S + BE + 3rd C + by... (+ C)
(subject) (verb) (complement)

→ describe a process

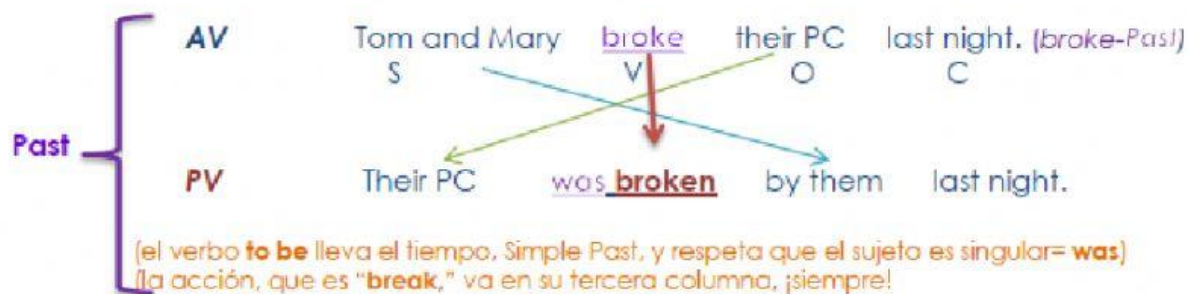
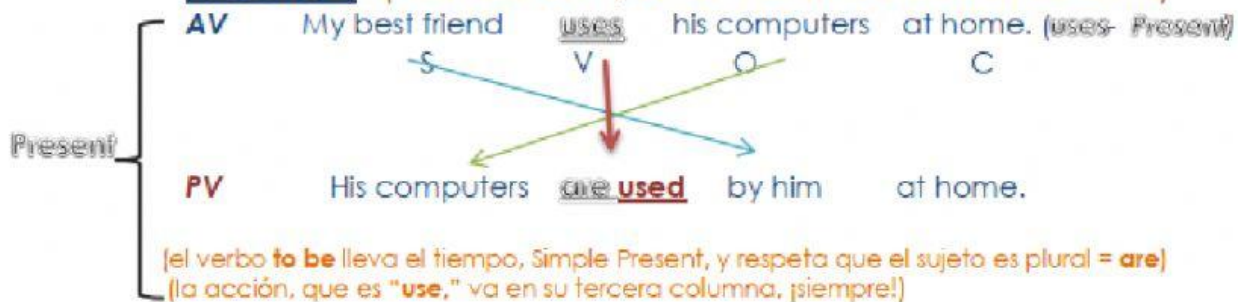
The Passive Voice is used to → express the importance of the action (quien hace la acción no es de suma importancia)
→ show sentence variety



La **PV** siempre va a estar conformada por dos partes: * *

* **TO BE** + * **3rd column of the main verb**
(el verbo **to be** respeta el tiempo verbal) (en la 3^a columna queda la acción)

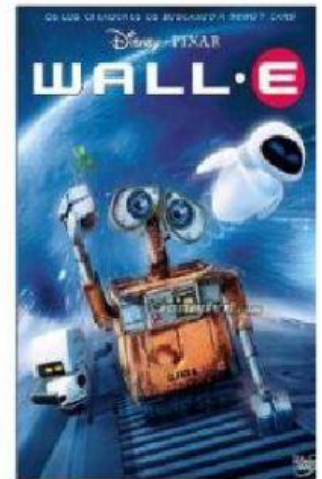
