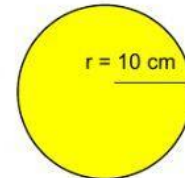
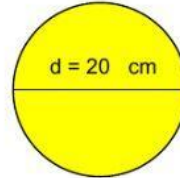

$$A = 3,14 \times \boxed{}^2 \text{ cm}$$

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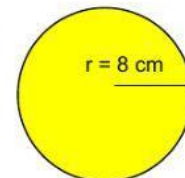
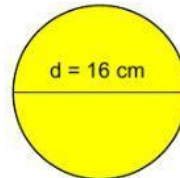
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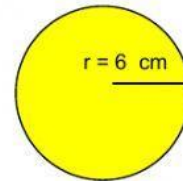
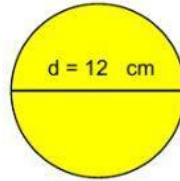
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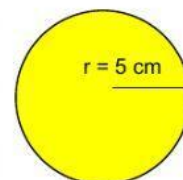
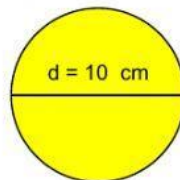
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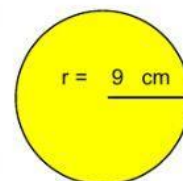
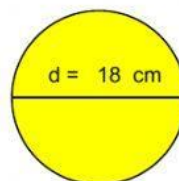
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
