1) Peter counted 140 ladybugs in a garden, and Lee counted 60 ladybugs outside of the garden. How many ladybugs did they count in all?

2) Shanika read some pages on Saturday. On Sunday, she read 60 pages. She read 130 pages during the weekend. How many pages did she read on Saturday?

Over the weekend, Shanika [read] _____ pages.

3) There were 60 turtles in the tank. Dad bought some more turtles. Now, there are 120 turtles. How many turtles did Dad buy?

✓ This is a joining scenario!

Dad [buy] _____ turtles.

4) Anton drove around the racetrack 12 times during the race. Rose drove around the racetrack 17 times. How many more times did Rose go around the racetrack than Anton?

✓ This is a comparing scenario!

Rose [go] around the track _____ more times than Anton.

5) Tamra decorated 13 cookies. Kiana decorated 5 fewer cookies than Tamra. How many cookies did Kiana decorate?
✓ This is a comparing scenario!

Kiana [decorate] _____ cookies.

6) After the rainstorm, Willie splashed in 7 more puddles than Julio. Willie splashed in 11 puddles. How many puddles did Julio splash in?

✓ This is a comparing scenario!

Julio [splash] in _____ puddles.

7) Maria jumped off the diving board into the pool 3 fewer times than Emi. Maria jumped off the diving board 14 times. How many times did Emi jump off the diving board?

✓ This is a comparing scenario!

Emi [jump] off the diving board _____ times.

8) Emi applied for 10 fewer jobs than Nikil. Emi applied for 18 jobs. How many jobs did Nikil apply for?

✓ This is a comparing scenario!

Nikil [apply] for _____ jobs.

9) Jenny saw 26 movies last year. This year, she saw 18 movies. How many movies did Jenny see in both years?

✓ This is a joining scenario!

Jenny [see] _____ movies in both years.

10) At Home Depot, an electric power drill costs \$12 less than a rechargeable power drill. The electric power drill costs \$30. How much does the rechargeable power drill cost?

✓ This is a comparing scenario!

The rechargeable power drill [cost] _____ dollars.
