On Wednesday, we were on the underground a lot, visiting lots of places. Some of the

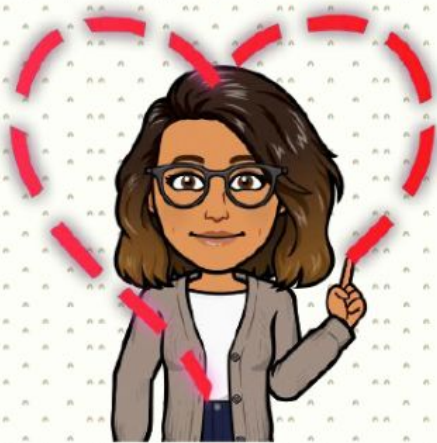
underground was really new for the Olympics.
