A Truly Natural Wonder

The Iguazu Falls are one of the most impressive natural landmarks in Argentina. These waterfalls of the Iguazu River are located on the border of Argentina and Brazil. Tourists should definitely visit the national parks that protect these waterfalls to really enjoy all the natural beauty that this area offers.

One of the most interesting attractions is *Garganta del Diablo* (*the Devil's Throat*), the highest point of the falls which is 82 metres high. Visitors can have access to the falls if they take an ecological train that allows them to explore the jungle and observe the local fauna. There are also some trails that lead to these magnificent waterfalls. It is also possible to take boat rides that go near the falls and give people the opportunity to come into close contact with this natural wonder. Another popular tourist point is where the Parana and Iguazu rivers meet (which is also the bordering area of three countries: Argentina, Brazil and Paraguay).



Travellers shouldn't visit the Iguazú Falls in summer because it is hotter and wetter than during the rest of the seasons. They should also try to avoid visiting the area in winter because the river water level is relatively low.

This incredible tourist destination offers a variety of outdoor activities too and there are many good hotels on both sides of the Iguazu River. Visitors are then guaranteed spectacular views of the falls from their hotel rooms and they can also enjoy...
