1. Let us make a group of 3 roses



Number of groups =
Number of roses in each group =
 $3+3 = \underline{\quad}$
 $2 \times 3 = \underline{\quad}$

2. Let us make a group of 2 chocolates



Number of groups =
Number of chocolates in each group =
 $2+2+2+2 = \underline{\quad}$
 $4 \times 2 = \underline{\quad}$

3. Let us make a group of 5 apples



Number of groups =
Number of apples in each group =
 $5+5+5+5+5+5+5 = \underline{\quad}$
 $7 \times 5 = \underline{\quad}$
