MAMMA MIA !

Mamma Mia started off as a chart-topping pop song in 1975 by the Swedish pop group ABBA. Then it became a musical stage show featuring a whole collection of ABBA songs. Finally it became a blockbuster musical film starring Meryl Streep, Colin Firth, Pierce Brosnan, Stellan Skarsgard and Amanda Seyfried.

ABBA was one of the most successful pop bands in Europe. They were on top of the music charts around the world from 1972 to 1982. They sold over 375 million records globally. There were four members, two women and two men who were also married couples. The couples split up in 1979 and 1981 and then finally the band split up in 1983.

The stage show is a global phenomenon and is currently doing an international tour as well as permanently playing in London's West End and on Broadway in New York. It came about in 1999. It was the idea of British producer Judy Craymer. She got permission from Benny Andersson and Bjorn Ulvaeus from ABBA to use their songs and hired playwright Catherine Johnson to write the book for the musical. The show was an instant success and today it has versions in 16 different languages.
