- A.** When meeting someone for the first time, it is customary to shake hands, both for men and for women. Hugs are only exchanged between close friends. Kissing is not common, and men never kiss other men. Americans will usually introduce themselves by their first name and last name (such as «Hello, I'm John Smith»), or, if the setting is very casual, by their first name only («Hi, I'm John»). The common response when someone is introduced to you is «Pleased to meet you»
- B.** In the US there are only a few situations where tipping is expected. The one you will encounter most often is at restaurants. American restaurants do not add a service charge to the bill. Therefore, it is expected that the customer will leave a tip for the server. Common practice is to leave a tip that is equal to 15% of the total bill for acceptable service. Other professions where tipping is expected include hairdressers, taxi drivers, hotel porters, parking valets, and bartenders.
- C.** Many visitors who come to Britain often say that it is very difficult to make friends with British people because they are cold and reserved. This is not true. What is true is that different cultures have different ways of showing affection. British people are not likely to tell their whole life story to a complete stranger or even share their problems and worries with a friend. The reason is that they don't want to trouble other people with their problems.
- D.** Britain's national sport is not, as most people think, football but the Lottery. It may also be surprising to know that the people who gamble most on the Lottery are not well-off but mostly working class people who hope that by winning the Lottery they will change their lives. Even though everyone who buys a lottery ticket knows that the chances of them becoming millionaires are incredibly slim, it doesn't stop British people from spending huge money on lottery tickets and trying their luck *every* week.
- E.** You can 'break the ice' with strangers by talking about the weather. "Shame about the weather", "Is it still raining?" or "Bit chilly today, don't you think?" Another good topic for conversation is work. However, English people do not like talking about the politics except in a general way. And you should avoid asking them what political party they vote for. It is not appropriate to ask people about their age or how much they earn.
- F.** Like everybody else, British people like doing things outside work. Gardening is a well-known favourite. As the weather in Britain is relatively mild, British people manage to do gardening almost all the year round. Sometimes this can be just doing a bit of weeding, and sometimes serious vegetable and fruit growing. Mowing grass is also very important. Every Sunday morning (except for winter) people come out to mow their lawns.

#### **A LEGEND**

'Follow me,' he told them. 'I'll lead you to a new and better life.'

Ayar Manco looked for a good place to build the city for many days. Every day the wild people watched as he tried to push the golden rod into the soil. But he had no success. Ayar Manco was beginning to lose hope. At last he arrived at a beautiful place situated high in the mountains. Here the golden rod sank easily into the rich soil.

So, they started building but work was almost impossible because a very strong wind was blowing. Ayar Manco managed to catch the wind in a cave, rolling a very large rock across the entrance.

But soon Ayar Manco's brother arrived and saw that the wind was locked in the cave. He was angry.

'How could you do this to my friend!' he cried and promised to free the wind at sunset.

Ayar Manco knew that it was impossible to finish building the whole city before sunset, so he made another plan.
