## **Possessive Nouns**

A **possessive noun** names who or what owns or has something. The possessive of a singular noun is formed by adding -'s. The possessive of a plural noun that ends in s is formed by adding -s'. The possessive of a plural noun that does not end in s, such as *men*, is formed by adding -'s.

singular possessive noun

That is my mother's flute.

plural possessive noun that ends in s

Our friends' classes are on the other side of the stage.

plural possessive noun that does not end in s

The men's dressing room is downstairs.

## Plural or Possessive? Don't panic! Possessive nouns are followed by another noun.

My teacher's hair was all ruffled this morning.

If it's a plural noun, it won't have an apostrophe (it doesn't need it) and it won't be followed by another noun.

The <u>teachers</u> at school drink lots of coffee.
