English originated in England, but soon English spread to other countries, and different varieties of English began to exist. Today, the countries in which English is spoken can be divided into three groups. The first group is made of those countries where English is the primary language. These are countries like England, Canada, the United States, Ireland, Australia and New Zealand. There are more than 380 million native speakers of English in these countries alone.
