-ES if the verbs ends in
-o/-sh/ -ch/ -ss

For example:

Go -> Goes

Wash -> Washes

Watch -> Watches



I **don't** kill insects

You **don't** dance hip-hop

María **doesn't** like football

We **don't** get bored

You **don't** pay much attention

They **don't** listen to music

We use: **don't**

3rd person: We use **doesn't**



Do I love to teach 6^º grade?

Yes, I do

Do you like María's songs? **Yes, you do**

Does Noa paint during classes?

Yes, she does

Do we like English classes?

Yes, we do

Do you do your homework?

No, you don't

Do Álex, Alexandra, and Toni wear fashionable clothes?

Yes, they do

We start with: **Do ?**

- **Yes, you do**
- **No, they don't**

3rd person: We start with:

Does she/he/the teacher/Dylan/Lidia ?

- **Yes, he/she does**
- **No, he/she doesn't**
