

The Simple Present and Simple Past

a) Regular Verbs

examples:	simple present:	I <u>work</u> in a school. (to work)
	simple past:	I <u>worked</u> in a school. (to work)
	simple present:	He <u>lives</u> in Berlin. (to live)
	simple past:	He <u>lived</u> in Berlin. (to live)



1)	simple present:	Normally, Maria	through the garden. (to walk)
	simple past:	Yesterday, Maria	through the garden. (to walk)
2)	simple present:	I	a movie in the cinema. (to watch)
	simple past:	Last night, I	a movie in the cinema. (to watch)
3)	simple present:	Martha and Ann	until 8 p.m.. (to work)
	simple past:	Yesterday, Martha and Ann	until 8 p.m.. (to work)
4)	simple present:	My mother	to learn Spanish. (to learn)
	simple past:	Last weekend, my mother	to learn Spanish. (to learn)
5)	simple present:	Normally, James	a lot of questions. (to ask)
	simple past:	Last week, James	a lot of questions. (to ask)
6)	simple present:	I	to eat a cheese burger. (to want)
	simple past:	Yesterday, I	to eat a cheese burger. (to want)
