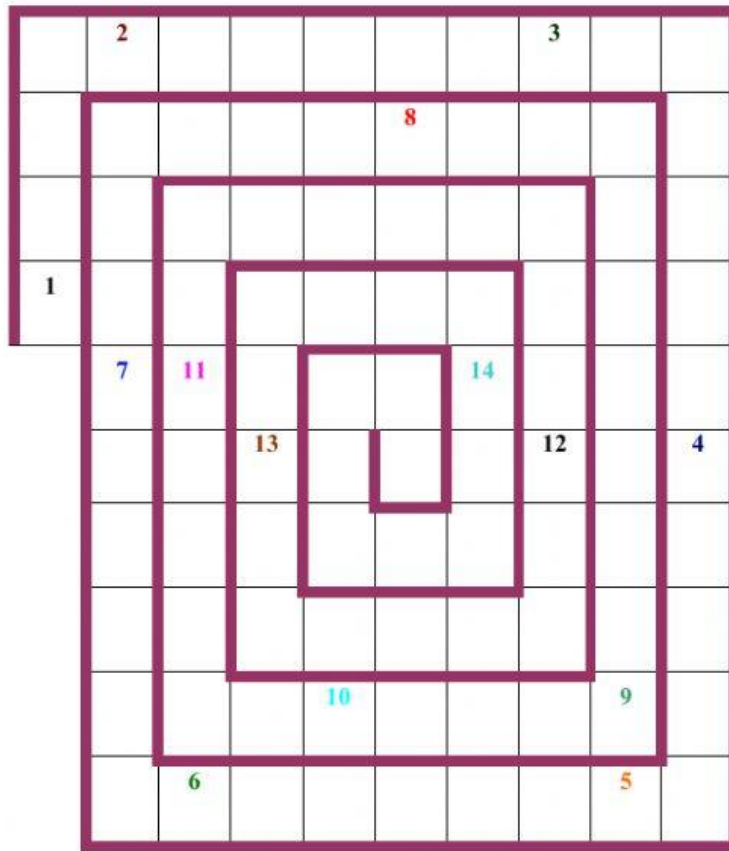


## COMPARATIVE SPIRAL
