

## LOS MANDATOS INFORMALES (tú)

Commands are a part of everyday life. How we make commands in Spanish depends upon whom we are speaking to. Let's start with informal commands first. These are the types of commands we give to friends, some family members and those that are younger than we are.

### Informal commands (affirmative)

These are very simple to form. Just take the \_\_\_\_\_ form and drop the \_\_\_\_\_.

(This is the same thing as just using the \_\_\_\_\_ / \_\_\_\_\_ / \_\_\_\_\_ form if that's easier for you.)

### What about the irregular affirmative commands?

These are the verbs that are used over and over again as they have been shortened down through the centuries. They're pretty easy to remember since they are almost all -go verbs.
