When we talk about routines and habits, we use the **present simple**.

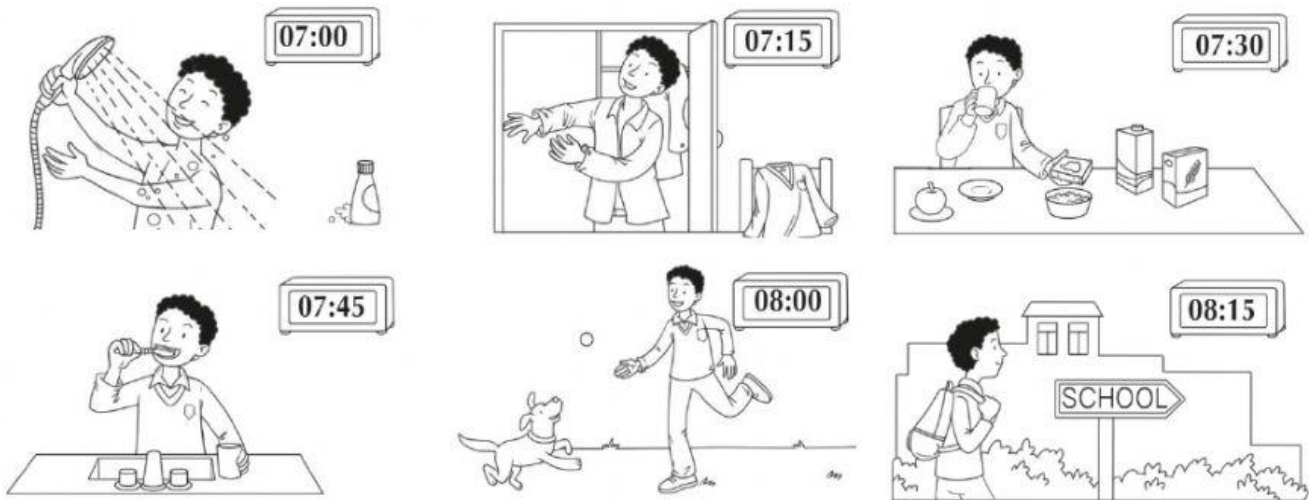
Before I go to school, I brush my teeth.
