Study the following:

<b>Put on</b> (an exhibition)	to organize an event
<b>Turn up</b> (no object)	to arrive
<b>Turn</b> (sound, volume) <b>up</b>	to increase the volume
<b>Carry out</b>	to do a particular piece of work, research etc
<b>Set out</b>	to arrange something in a clear and detailed way/ arrange (table)
<b>Keep up</b>	to continue to do something
<b>Set apart</b> (from)	to make someone or something different and special
<b>Set up</b>	to start a business etc,/ organize or plan something
<b>Work out</b>	to solve a problem
