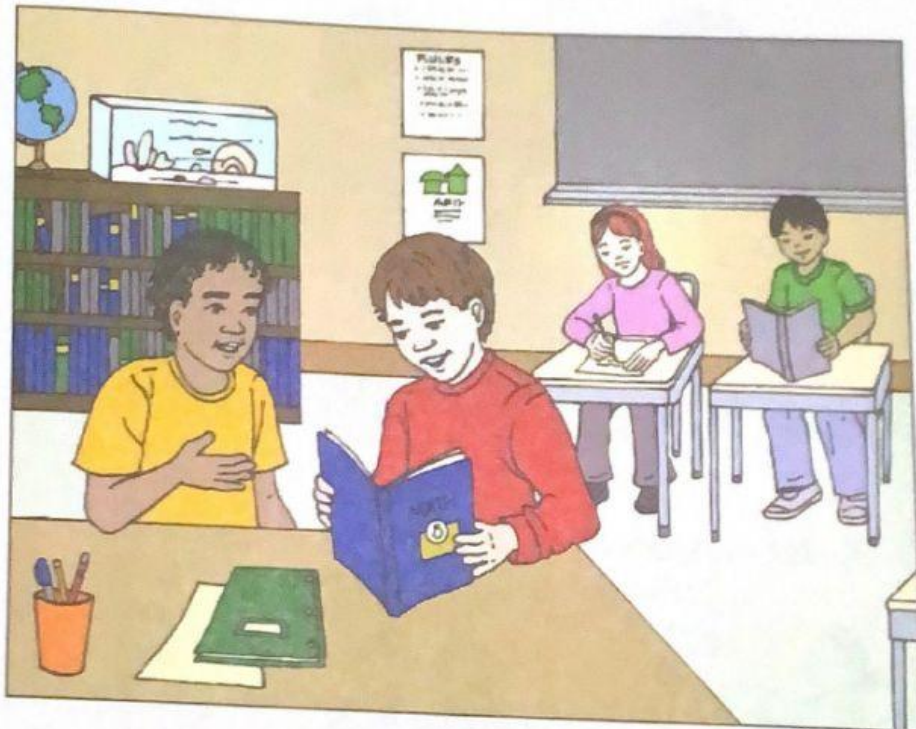




Getting Along

The second-grade class at Highfield Elementary School is learning about cooperation. Cooperation means working together and getting along.

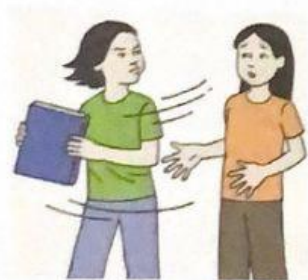

1. Which picture shows how Tina and Ann cooperate?

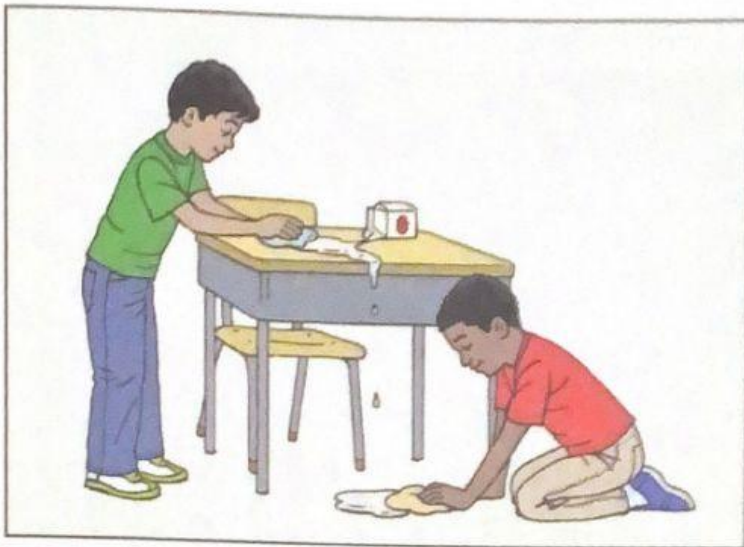

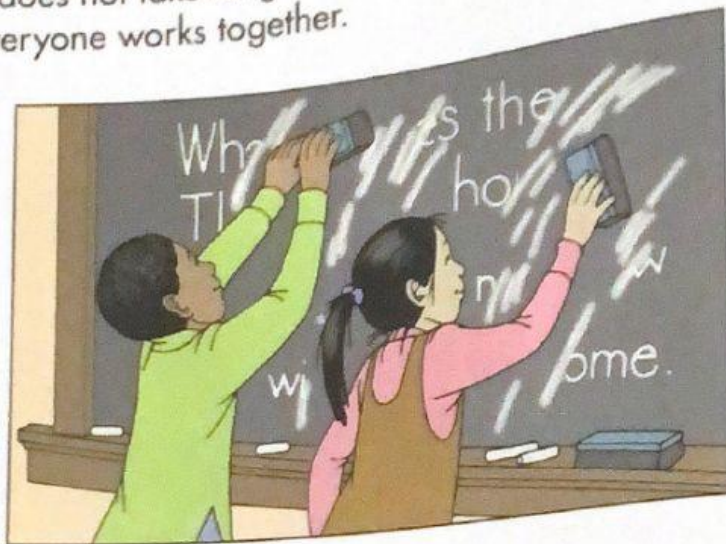


2. Haji wants to cooperate. What does he do?
