**d.-verb.** To produce or cause something.

**e.-verb.** To calculate what something will be in the future, using the information you have now.

**f.-phrasal verb.** To use all of something and not have any more left.

**g.-noun.** the cause of something, especially a problem, or the place where it starts.

**h.-noun.** An amount of something that is available to be used.

**i.-adjective.** Able to continue without causing damage to the environment.

**j.-verb.** To use time, energy, goods etc.

**k.-verb.** To completely get rid of something that is unnecessary or unwanted.

**l.-adjective.** Used when you want to emphasize that you mean all of a group, period of time, amount etc **SYN** whole.
