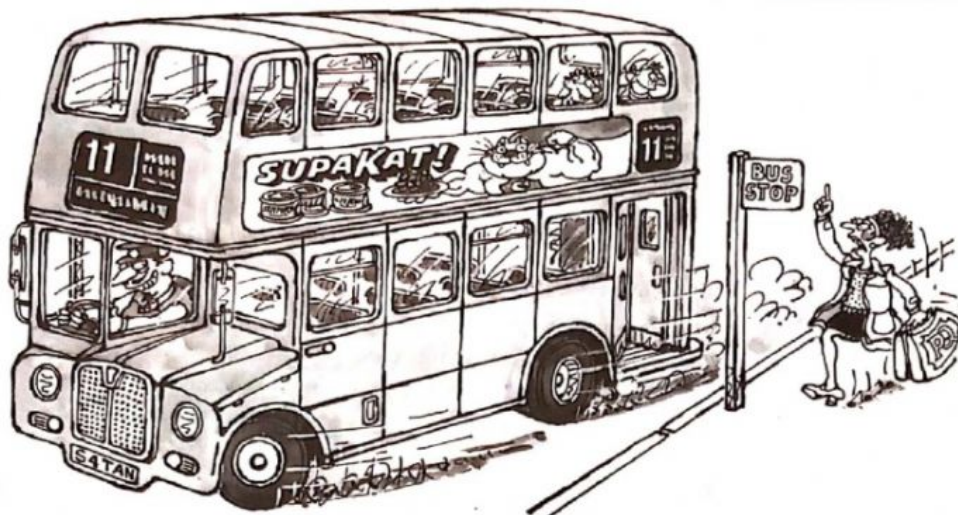


Third Conditional
