ADJECTIVE	COMPARATIVE	SUPERLATIVE
ONE syllable	- ER	- EST
fast young	faster younger	the fastest the youngest

COMPARATIVE A dog is **faster** than an elephant.
adjective + er
~~more fast~~ ✗

SUPERLATIVE The horse is **the fastest**. ✓ (of the three animals)
the adjective + est

TWO or MORE Syllables	MORE +	THE MOST +
famous expensive	more famous more expensive	the most famous the most expensive

COMPARATIVE more + adjective
A car is **more expensive** than a bike.

SUPERLATIVE the most + adjective
The plane is **the most expensive** way to travel.
