### **The Statue of Liberty**

Located in New York , the USA;

Located in Giza , Egypt

### **COLOSSEUM**

Located in Rome, Italy  
It is the largest amphitheatre ever built.

### **Tower Bridge**

Located in London, England. Tower Bridge is a combined bascule and suspension bridge in London, built between 1886 and 1894. The bridge crosses the River Thames close to the Tower of London and has become a world-famous symbol of London.



### **Machu Picchu**

Located in the eastern Cordillera of Southern Peru on a 2,430-metre mountain ridge. It was founded around 1450 by the Incas but it was abandoned by them at the time of the Spanish conquest in 1572.  
It is the most familiar icon of Inca civilization.  
Machu Picchu was built in the classical Inca style, with polished dry-stone walls. Its three primary structures are the Intihuatana, the Temple of the Sun, and the Room of the Three Windows. Most of the outlying buildings have been reconstructed in order to give tourists a better idea of how they originally appeared. By 1976, 30% of Machu Picchu had been restored and restoration continues.
