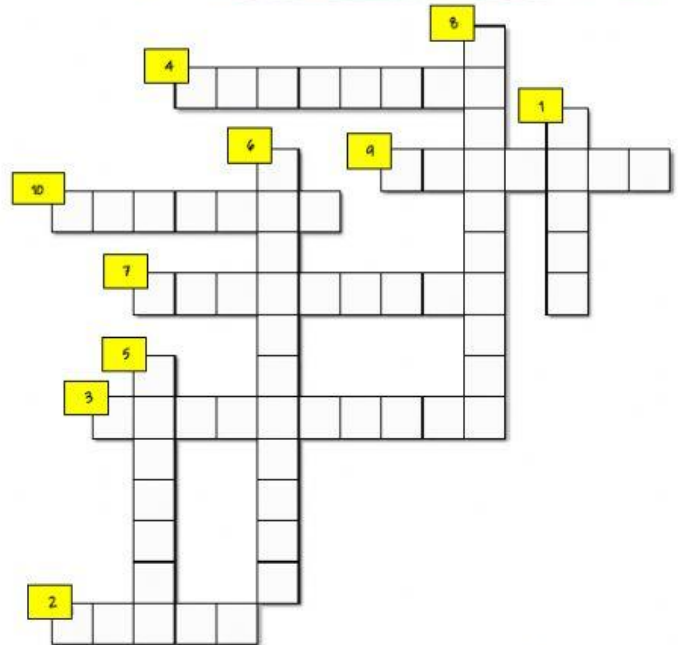

Sunflower is a big flower. It looks like a flower face of bright yellow petals and brown centers that ripen into heavy heads filled with seeds.

Sunflowers are heliotrope, which means that they turn their flowers to follow the movement of the sun across the sky.

Some sunflowers grow to over 16 feet in height, though there are also varieties today that have been developed for small spaces and containers.

Most sunflowers are easy to grow as long as the soil is not waterlogged. They make excellent cut flowers and many are attractive to bees and birds.

At the end of the season, it is easy to harvest sunflower seeds for a tasty snack or for replanting.

In Chaing Rai, there is a popular tourist attraction to see these big flowers. Rai Saen Kham Rak - Thoeng district is a beautiful place to see them in the winter season. There are a lot of sunflowers around the hill. Tourists prefer to take photos with them.
