Write 2 division facts for the following multiplication facts .

One is done for you.

Example

$5 \times 2 = 10$

$10 \div 2 = 5$

$10 \div 5 = 2$

$6 \times 2 = 12$

$7 \times 5 = 35$

$8 \times 4 = 32$

$9 \times 3 = 27$

$8 \times 7 = 56$

$6 \times 7 = 42$

$3 \times 8 = 24$

$5 \times 9 = 45$

$9 \times 7 = 63$

$4 \times 10 = 40$
