

BEAKS

Read the information and match with the correct bird



It has a **small wide beak** which it opens wide like a *butterfly net* to catch **insects** when it flies.



FINCH



It has a **small beak** with the shape of a **cone**, that it uses like a *hammer* to crack **hard seeds and nuts**.



HUMMINGBIRD



Its **thin beak** is like a *straw* to sip **nectar** from the flowers.



DUCK



It has a **long beak** like *tongs*, and it swallows the **prey whole**.



HERON



It has a **sharp beak** with the shape of a *hook* which it uses to tear the **flesh of the prey**.



WOODPECKER



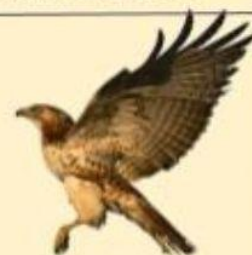
It has got a **strong beak** like a *chisel*, which it uses to drill the barks of the trees and find **insects and fruit**.



SWALLOW



It has a **flat beak** with very small teeth, which works as a *strainer*; the water goes out and the **small water animals** (crabs, snails, lobsters, clams, etc) get caught inside.
